You can best support your child by:

### REGULAR READING

Please listen to your child read to you every night if at all possible. Being able to read is such a boost to children's self-esteem and obviously opens up the rest of the curriculum.

A competent reader will progress not only with their writing and spelling but will also be more confident in other subjects.

### Homework

Regular homework in Key Stage 2 will be reading, spellings and times tables. Some children will be given other English & Maths tasks as homework. Tests or spellings and times tables will be on a Thursday morning. Other pieces of homework may be given on occasion and these will be topic based.

## **BOOK BAGS**

Please check your child's book bag daily for letters etc. Stationary for all pupils will be provided for every child.

### WATER BOTTLES

Whatever the weather, please provide your child with a named bottle of <u>water</u> to keep in the class during the day.

# \*PE KIT

PE kits need to be kept at school and taken home on the last day of each half term for washing and sizing checks!

Your child will need suitable PE footwear (Velcro trainers unless your child is able to do their own laces please!) and clothing as per our uniform policy.
