English	Our English focus is stories on a theme: Daily life. We will be reading and discussing "No 1 Car Spotter" and " Anna Hibiscus"

	Spellings will continue to be tested each Thursday.

In Diamond class, we will continue to have a focus on times tables and the children will be tested each Thursday.

REGULAR READING

Please read two or three pages with your child each night. <u>IT IS VITAL YOUR CHILD READS AT HOME AT LEAST 5 TIMES A WEEK.</u> We would much rather they read one page a night than five pages once a week. As previously mentioned, children who read five times at home during the week will choose a small prize in recognition of their effort.

HOMEWORK

Homework will be set every Friday and is to be returned the following Thursday. This will comprise of your child learning spellings and times tables that are tailored to their learning need. Spellings will be sent home in a folder on a sheet of paper with a space to practise the words for five days each week using the LOOK>READ>COVER>WRITE>CHECK method. Please ensure your child writes a sentence for each spelling to show understanding.

Times tables need to be practiced until children are confident to answer questions out of order.
